Council Member Magee advised that AB 2438 was vetoed by Governor Newsom, which would have codified the Climate Action Plan for Transportation Infrastructure (CAPTI) by requiring that specified State transportation funding programs incorporate components of CAPTI into its guidelines; shared that on October 12, 2022, the Riverside County Transportation Commission will vote on the approval of the \$120 million contract fort he SR71/SR91 interchange which is anticipated to be constructed from late 2022 through 2025; and invited the community to attend the SCCA Autocross weekend Saturday, October 22 and Sunday, October 23, 2022 at Diamond Stadium.

Council Member Tisdale reported on his attendance at the Western Riverside Council of Governments Executive Committee and Southwest Communities Financing Authority Board of Directors meetings; invited the community to the Veterans Day Observance Ceremony on November 11, 2022 at 9:00 a.m. at Diamond Stadium.
