Subject: Amendment No. 2 to the Cooperative Agreement between the State Of California Department Of Transportation and the City of Lake Elsinore for the Reconstruction of Interstate 15 (I-15)/Railroad Canyon Road Interchange and other roadway improvements

Recommendation

Approve and authorize the City Manager to execute the second amendment to the Cooperative Agreement between State of California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and the City of Lake Elsinore for the I-15/Railroad Canyon Interchange Improvements, in final form as approved by City Attorney.

Background

On December 22, 2008, the City entered into the Agreement for Project Development to improve the Railroad Canyon Road at I-15 interchange. The original Project Agreement terminated on December 31, 2014. On September 23, 2014, the City approved Amendment No. 1 extending the Agreement termination to completion of the Project and completion of an Agreement closure statement.

Discussion

The original agreement established that the City would develop, design and fund the Project Approval and Environmental Document (PA&ED), Plans, Specifications, and Estimate (PS&E), and Right of Way (R/W) phases of the project.

The Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC) is managing the Project on behalf of the City. Therefore, the City will not be responsible for performing and financing the PS&E and R/W phases of this Project. Therefore, Amendment No. 2 will remove all terms and conditions pertaining to the City's obligations for PS&E and R/W from the Project Agreement.

Fiscal Impact

No Additional Fiscal Impact from the amendment. Cost of the project is funded by SB1, TUMF, STIP, and RIP funding.
