**Subject: Construction Agreement to Roadway Engineering and Contracting Inc. for the Riverside Drive at Lincoln Realignment / Widening Project (CIP PROJECT #Z10060).**

### **Recommendations**

1. Award a Construction Agreement to Roadway Engineering and Contracting Inc. for the Riverside Drive at Lincoln Realignment / Widening Project (CIP PROJECT #Z10060).
2. Approve, appropriate and authorize the City Manager to execute the Agreement in the not to exceed amount of \$692,400 with Roadway Engineering and Contracting Inc. in the form attached and in such final form as approved by the City Attorney.
3. Authorize the City Manager to execute change orders not to exceed a 10% contingency amount of \$69,240.00 for underground uncertainties and adjustments.

### **Background**

Construction bid documents were prepared and the project was advertised for bid in accordance with the requirements set forth in the California Public Contract Code. On August 24, 2018, the City posted on PlanetBids the notice inviting bids for the Riverside Drive at Lincoln Realignment / Widening Project (CIP PROJECT #Z10060).

Three bids were received on or before the deadline of 2:00 p.m. on Wednesday, September 26, 2018. All Bids were publicly opened, examined and declared in City Hall. Following the examination of the bids the low bidder, Roadway Engineering and Contracting Inc. was reviewed and interviewed by staff and determined complete.

### **Discussion**

The purpose of this Notice Inviting Bids is to seek competitive pricing for the Riverside Drive at Lincoln Realignment / Widening Project (CIP PROJECT #10060)
