Subject: Public Works Construction Agreement for Riverside Construction Company, Inc., for the Camino Del Norte Improvement Project CIP No. Z10030

Recommendation

1. Award the Public Works Construction Agreement for the Camino Del Norte Improvement Project CIP No. Z10030.
2. Authorize the City Manager to execute the Agreement in the amount of \$3,437,314 to Riverside Construction Company, Inc., in substantially the form attached and in such final form as approved by the City Attorney.
3. Authorize the City Manager to execute change orders not to exceed the 15% contingency amount of \$515,597.
4. Authorize the Acting City Engineer to record the Notice of Completion once it is determined the work is complete and the improvements are accepted into the City maintained roadway network.

Background

This project includes the realignment of Canyon Estates Drive and the extension of Camino Del Norte. The limits of the realignment/extension are from approximately 500 feet south of Franklin Street to 1,200 feet south of Main Street. The Camino Del Norte Improvement Project consists of constructing new roadway; drainage cross culverts and inlets; sidewalks, curb and gutter; and a traffic signal at the intersection of Canyon Estate Drive-Camino Del Norte at Franklin Street intersection. The project was advertised via PlanetBids on November 1, 2018.

Discussion

Contractor bids were opened publicly on December 13, 2018, at 2:00 p.m. The City received six (6) bids from qualified contractors. Staff recommends the selection of the lowest bidder. The bid results are summarized below:

Eagle Paving Company, Inc.	\$8,568,797.80

The contractor will start as soon as they get contracts executed, insurance and bonds in place and they mobilize with construction estimated to take 6-8 months. The City is tentatively looking at issuing a Notice to Proceed for construction by January 31, 2019 and construction will begin on realignment of Canyon Estates Drive and proceed from that direction to align with Camino Del Norte.

Fiscal Impact

Funding for this project has been allocated under the City's adopted CIP.
