Subject: SB-1 2019 Downtown Pavement Resurfacing Project Phase I

Recommendation

Adopt A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A LIST OF PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019-20 FUNDED BY SB 1: THE ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT OF 2017

Approve the submission of the Downtown Pavement Resurfacing Projects for SB-1 funding. The purpose of these projects is to improve the condition rating of the downtown area. The application due date for SB-1 projects is May 1, 2019.

Background

Bucknam Infrastructure Group performed a Pavement Assessment in 2017. Based on the pavement condition survey (9/8/2017), the downtown pavement condition indexes vary between 1 to 76, on a scale from 0 to 100. Resurfacing recommendations are divided into categories based on the various conditions:

- 2" Grind and Overlay
- 3" Grind and Overlay
- Slurry Seal

Discussion

Phase I of the downtown pavement resurfacing project will include sections at a 2" grind and overlay, along with sections at a 3" grind and overlay with a small portion of the area being scheduled for a slurry seal.

The Phase I downtown pavement resurfacing project areas are listed in the Table below:

The estimated cost for the downtown resurfacing of Phase I is \$1,583,594.00. Once SB-1 funding is secured, projects from the list above will be advertised for bid. The City of Lake Elsinore's projected SB-1 allocation for FY 2019-2010 is \$1,031,103. Projects listed above have been included in order to take advantage of funds that may become available.

Fiscal Impact

The funding allocation for the 2019 Downtown Pavement Resurfacing Project Phase I will be from the allocated SB-1 funds available with the remainder being funded from TRIPP funds.
