**Subject: Construction Contract Award for SB 821 Sumner, Davis, and Mohr Street Curb, Gutter, and Sidewalk Project CIP Project No. Z10010**

### **Recommendation**

1. Award the Public Works Construction Agreement for the SB 821 Sumner, Davis, and Mohr Street Curb, Gutter and Sidewalk Project to Black Rock Construction.
2. Authorize the City Manager to execute the Agreement in the amount of \$249,000 to Black Rock Construction, in substantially the form attached and in such final form as approved by the City Attorney.
3. Authorize the City Manager to execute change orders not to exceed the 10% contingency amount of \$24,900.
4. Authorize the City Engineer to record the Notice of Completion once it is determined the work is complete and the improvements are accepted into the City maintained roadway network.

### **Background**

On June 26, 2017, City received confirmation from Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC), that certain proposed project as part of SB 821 Grant were approved for funding. SB 821 Sumner, Davis and Mohr Street Curb, Gutter and Sidewalk was one of them.

On March 29, 2019, the project was advertised via Planetbids.

On April 30, 2019, the bids were opened.

### **Discussion**

Contractor bids were opened publicly on April 30, 2019, at 2:30 p.m. The City received five (5) bids from qualified contractors. Staff recommends the selection of the apparent low bidder Black Rock Construction. The bid results are summarized below:
