**Subject:** Amendment No. 7 To Agreement For TUMF Regional Arterial Improvements For The I-15/Railroad Canyon Road Interchange Project

### **Recommendation**

Authorize the City Manager to execute Amendment No. 7 with Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC) in final form as approved by City Attorney.

### **Background**

The original Agreement was executed February 4, 2010 (Master Agreement). As amended the Master Agreement provides terms and conditions related to scope of work and funding for the Project Approval and Environmental Document (PAED) phase of the Railroad Canyon Road at the I-15 interchange Improvements. Amendments 1 through 6 were executed between June 2011 and June 2018 to address PS&E (Plans, Specifications, and Estimate) Phase of the project.

Amendment No. 7 is intended to set terms for funding of the Construction phase of the project, where RCTC shall continue management activities required to complete the construction of the interchange improvements.

### **Discussion**

Amendment No. 7 allocates TUMF Regional Funds to the City, for distribution to RCTC, as the agency awarding and administering construction management and construction contract for the work.

The Work shall be consistent with the following defined RCTC award for services detailed as follows:

- 1) Construction Management Services.
- 2) Construction Contract.

It is agreed that the TUMF Regional Funds shall be expended only as set forth in the Agreement.

**Fiscal Impact**

The allocation of \$22,248,700 in TUMF funding towards the construction of the I-15/Railroad Canyon Road Interchange Improvements.
