Subject:	Application and Acceptance of the Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG 2017)

Recommendations

- 1. Authorize the application and accept the Emergency Services Grant for the Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG 17); and,
- 2. Authorize revenue appropriation of \$16,253 to Emergency Services Grant Revenue (100-9999-4703) to offset the EMPG17 expense.

Background

The Public Works Department recently accepted on behalf of the City, an invitation to apply for the FY2017 Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG-17); award amount will be disclosed on approval of application. This grant is a dollar-for-dollar match. Upon receipt of the notification from Cal-OES of the grant approval, the City will then be required to commence the purchasing process for the amount of the grant.

Discussion

These funds are used to sustain the Emergency Services capabilities for cities. The Public Works Department will use this grant to offset the cost for Emergency Services training and supplies.

Fiscal Impact

The Emergency Management Performance Grant Program (EMPG17) provides cost reimbursement up to 50% with a minimum 50% local match (\$16,139), for which the City will use the Public Works Emergency Services Fund.
