### **Recommendations**

Approve Application and Authorize accept of the Emergency Services Grant for the Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP-17); and,

adopt A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAKE ELSINORE, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING DESIGNATED CITY EMPLOYEES TO TAKE ACTION NECESSARY FOR OBTAINING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FRM THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY, HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM (HSGP-17) FOR FISCAL YEAR 2017/2018

#### **Background**

An invitation to apply for the FY2017/2018 Homeland Security Grant Program (HSGP-17) was accepted on behalf of the City by the Public Works Department; award amount is \$8,858. This grant is 75% full reimbursement. Upon receipt of the notification from Cal-OES of the grant approval, the City will then be required to commence the purchasing process for the grant.

### **Discussion**

These funds are used to sustain the Emergency Services capabilities for cities. The Public Works Department will use this grant to offset the cost for Emergency Services Training supplies, CERT class materials and training equipment to better prepare residents in our community.
