Subject: Amendment No. 4 to Extend the Term and Adjust Compensation of the Tri-Star Electric's Agreement for Contractor Services (On-call) in FY18-19

#### **Recommendation**

Approve and authorize the City Manager to execute Amendment No. 4 to extend the contract with Tri-Star Electric for on-call contractor services, an additional 12-term, for a not to exceed contract amount of \$30,000, in such final form as approved by the City Attorney.

#### Background

A contract with Tri-Star Electric executed on July1, 2016 for on-call contractor services in the amount of \$5,000, was amended three time, for a contract a total amount of \$55,000. The original contract offered the option of extending three (3) additional 12-month terms. If approved, Amendment No. 4 will be the second extension to the contract.

## Discussion

Tri-Star Electric has proven to a reliable contractor in providing on-call contractor services for unexpected work performed on an emergency basis or with very short notice. Staff is requesting to extend the contract an additional 12-month term, for a contract total not to exceed amount of \$30,000 for FY 18/19.

Funding is available in the FY 2018-19 Public Works Operations budget.
