CALL TO ORDER

1) Approval of Minutes – September 18, 2018 and October 02, 2018.

PUBLIC HEARING ITEM(S)

2) <u>Variance No. 2018-01 - A Request to Reduce the Minimum 60 Ft. Street Frontage Width Required by the R-1 Zone to 50 Ft. for 10 Lots and Reduce the Minimum Lot Size from 6,000 Sq. Ft. to 4,500 Sq. Ft. for 12 Lots for a Previously Approved Tentative Tract Map No. 32129.</u>
