Subject: Agreement for Professional Civil Engineering and Design Services to KTUA

for the Downtown Active Transportation Connections and Green Streets

Project for Spring Street

Recommendation

Authorize the City Manager to execute a contract for professional design services in the amount of \$219,805 to KTUA, plus an additional 10% contingency, in such final form as approved by the City Attorney.

Background

In May 2019, the City was awarded \$1,194,606.00 from the California Natural Resources Agency (CNRA) for a streetscape, sidewalk and road improvements along Spring Street from West Flint Street to Graham Avenue, and include enhancements to west Pottery Street, West Sumner Avenue, West Franklin Street, West Heald Avenue and West Peck Avenue.

The City published a Request for Proposal on June 24, 2019 for design elements including carbon sequestration plants and trees, sidewalks, lighting conduit and street slurry sealing and lining.

On August 5, 2019 interviews were held with four firms that submitted Proposals for the Project; all firms met the requirements for interviews. At the conclusion of the interviews, KTUA was selected to develop design plans for the project.

Discussion

The Professional Service Contract will Authorize KTUA to start the design of the Downtown Active Transportation Connections and Green Streets for Spring Street project. The design will provide plans to go out for bid and construction of the project.

Fiscal Impact

Professional Services Contract will result into a cost of \$219,805 plus an additional 10% in contingency.
