**Subject: Award the Professional Services Agreement for David Evans and Associates, Inc., for the Main Street Interchange Wall Aesthetic Treatment**

### **Recommendation**

Award the Agreement for Professional Services to David Evans and Associates, Inc., for architectural services for the wall aesthetic treatment along the Main Street in the amount of \$43,980 in substantially the form attached in such final form as approved by the City Attorney.

### **Background**

Art and aesthetic design services are required for perforated art panels for the abutment walls at the I-15/Main Street Interchange. The art panels will reflect the local culture and influence of the City. David Evans and Associates has been previously retained by the City to provide landscape architectural and design services for the wall aesthetic treatment along Railroad Canyon Interchange.

### **Discussion**

The "Transportation Art" process adopted by Caltrans requires that designs for art and aesthetic panels are reviewed by Headquarters for conformance with Caltrans standards and general practices. David Evans and City staff will work with Caltrans at the District and Headquarters levels in order to provide plans, specifications, and all necessary documents for the reviewers in order to expedite the approval process. The contract will also allow the consultant's team to address Caltrans comments and make revisions as necessary to approve the artwork for installation at Main Street walls at the abutments.

### **Fiscal Impact**

Sufficient budget is contained in the adopted Capital Improvement Program budget.
