Subject: Amendment No. 1 to the Professional Services Agreement with GeoMat Testing Laboratories, Inc. for the Camino Del Norte Improvement Project CIP No. Z10030

Recommendation

Authorize the City Manager to execute Amendment No. 1 to the Agreement for Professional Services with GeoMat Testing Laboratories, Inc., for construction geotechnical services on the Camino Del Norte Improvement Project in the amount of \$38,930 plus a 10% contingency, in a form as approved by the City Attorney.

Background

The Camino Del Norte project includes the realignment of Canyon Estates Drive and the extension of Camino Del Norte. The limits of the realignment/extension are from approximately 500 feet south of Franklin Street to 1,200 feet south of Main Street. The Camino Del Norte Improvement Project consists of constructing new roadway; drainage cross culverts and inlets; sidewalks, curb and gutter; and a traffic signal at the intersection of Canyon Estate Drive-Camino Del Norte at Franklin Street intersection.

Discussion

GeoMat Testing Laboratories, Inc., provided geotechnical services during the construction phase of the Camino Del Norte extension project, including establishing the over excavation limits per plan, bottom excavation observed for elevation competency, subbase material suitability, compaction tests, AC Temperature Monitoring, Soil Density, Aggregate Gradation, Trench Stability and other geotechnical testing as required by the project.

Amendment No. 1 will allow GeoMat to invoice 158 hours for work already performed during construction phase of the project for the months of January and February. In addition, it will allow GeoMat to provide geotechnical field services during the installation of long-term erosion control BMP's and over-side drainage conveyance systems related to the work currently under design by Dost Engineering.

Fiscal Impact

Funding for this project has been allocated under the City's adopted CIP.
