2) <u>Planning Application No. 2019-57 (Summerly Neighborhood 21) - Design Review for the Construction of 75 Single-Family Residential Units in TR 31920-21.</u>

The Public Hearing was opened at 6:02 p.m. There were no conflict of Interest disclosures. Administrative Clerk Wells affirmed receipt of Proof of Publication and noted that correspondence had not been received.

Senior Planner Abraham presented the Staff report.

The applicant Ryan Cummins stated that he accepts all of the Conditions and said he was available for any questions.
